Youth ages 2-18 can receive free lunch, June 13 – August 26

**Las Vegas (May 26, 2011)** – The Bill & Lillie Heinrich YMCA is a participant in the summer food service program, a continuation of The National School Lunch Program, a federally assisted meal program providing nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to students. Youth ages 2-18 can receive a free lunch at the Heinrich YMCA from June 13 through August 26, Monday through Friday, 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. The Bill & Lillie Heinrich YMCA, 4141 Meadows Lane, is across from the Meadows Mall between Decatur Blvd. and Valley View Blvd.

Pre-registration is not required.
