

Jordan Sommaggio Appointed New CEO of the YMCA of Southern Nevada

The YMCA of Southern Nevada proudly announces the appointment of Jordan Sommaggio as its new President and CEO, effective January 1, 2025. Following a comprehensive national search, supported by YMCA of the USA, Sommaggio was chosen by the local chapter's Board of Directors to succeed the esteemed Mike Lubbe, who celebrates retirement after 41 years of service in the national YMCA Movement. In his new role, Sommaggio will continue Lubbe's legacy and work to expand the reach of the organization to serve our growing community.

With a 12-year history at the YMCA of Southern Nevada, and at only 32 years old, Sommaggio has demonstrated a steadfast commitment to the nonprofit's mission and local community. In his current role as Director of Development, Sommaggio quadrupled annual fundraising, which fueled the creation of innovative programs that meet the Valley's evolving needs, facilitated expansion into five new sites, and increased the organization's overall budget size by 50%.

Sommaggio's driving force is the quote "be who you needed when you were younger." This motto has inspired his success across multiple roles, including his former leadership of the nonprofit's largest Youth Development department. In this role, Sommaggio transformed the department from four programs with declining enrollment to a robust array of 16 programs with hundreds of children on waitlists.

A Las Vegas local and graduate of Bishop Gorman High School, Sommaggio earned an associate degree in psychology and bachelor's degrees in political science and criminal justice from Gonzaga University. He also holds a master's in nonprofit management and a Juris Doctor from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

"Jordan's vision and achievements are a testament to his dedication to making his local community stronger," said Todd Mayhew, Chairman of the YMCA Board. "We are confident that his leadership will guide the YMCA of Southern Nevada into an impactful future, benefitting our members, employees and our entire community."
