We host a number of events throughout the year to benefit our community that we simply could not do without the efforts of our volunteers.

Ongoing Volunteer Service

Volunteers serve in long-term roles ranging from office administration, guest speakers in teachers' classrooms, and in member services, among others. We provide a thorough on-boarding process to ensure your safety as well as that of our children, our members, and our Y. We make a significant investment in you and in return we ask you provide us with a regular commitment to service. Background checks are required.

One-Time and Special Event Volunteers

One-time and special event volunteers serve a very important role at the YMCA. Our process:

- Candidates who are not Y staff (e.g. Y members or individuals from the community) need to complete the volunteer agreement prior to volunteer service.
- A volunteer timesheet is required to be completed and submitted to humanresources@lasvegasyymca.org after the event.
- For corporate or group volunteers, we request that a representative for the group complete the volunteer agreement prior to the event, share the information with those from his/her company, and provide a roster of all volunteers who will participate to the volunteer manager prior to the event.

Field Trip Volunteers

Volunteers who accompany children on a one-time event such as a field trip must complete a volunteer agreement and criminal background check which must be cleared prior to the event. This includes parents of children attending the field trip or event.

Youth Volunteers

The Y encourages the involvement of youth in our community. Young adults age 16 and older may apply to volunteer roles for which they are qualified with parental permission as indicated on the volunteer application.

Candidates who are interested in ongoing service begin by filling out a volunteer application.

Step 2: On-boarding/Training

- Background Check (18+)
- Orientation

Step 3: Placement

- Interview with your supervisor
- Receive your service description
- Conduct timesheet training
- Receive your volunteer name tag
